Dear President Bush, Secretary Rice and Assistant Secretary Frazer:

We the undersigned are deeply concerned by the deteriorating situation in Darfur. More than one quarter of a million people have been forced from their homes, lands and livelihoods since the signing of the Darfur Peace Agreement in May 2006. Aid agencies are providing life saving services to 4 million people in Darfur, but are facing increasing attacks. Only 64% of Darfur is accessible to aid agencies, leaving more than half a million people without life-saving assistance. The Darfur crisis can only be solved through diplomacy. The United States has been a leader in calling attention to the crisis in Darfur, but further leadership by the United States is needed now more than ever. Therefore...

We call upon the United States Government to:

Bring together European allies, China, Russia, India and key Arab and African states in a united, coordinated effort to persuade the government of Sudan, the various rebel groups, and the militias to negotiate an effective ceasefire.

Ensure that all different ethnic groups have a stake in the peace process.

Ensure that Darfur is a top priority for public diplomacy, including public presidential statements and visits by senior officials.

Sustain provision of food, medicine, supplies and funding for Darfur for as long as it is needed.

Provide long-term reconstruction support once peace is secured.

Recognize that the Darfur conflict is but one integral part of a peace building effort for the whole region that encompasses South Sudan, Chad, and the Central African Republic.
